We use the Communicative Language Teaching (CLT) method in our classes. Courses

At BELS, we offer a wide selection of short-term, as well as long-term (8+ weeks), English courses comprising of General English, Business English and English for Special Purposes.

General English Standard

Number of Lessons: 20

Learners in Class: maximum 12, average 8

Course Description: This programme focuses on giving the learner balanced practice in both systems and skills using general topics. The course concentrates on all the four skills: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing with special emphasis on conversation, using general topics.

Duration: minimum 1 week

General English Mini

Number of Lessons: 20

Learners in Class: maximum 8, average 5

Course Description: The core teaching element of this course is the same as the standard course but the smaller number of students in the class ensures more student-teacher interaction, which will accelerate the learning process.

Duration: minimum 1 week

General English Mini Intensive

Number of Lessons: 30

Learners in Class: maximum 8, average 5

Course Description: The limited number of students in class and the additional lessons provide the opportunity for more individual attention and focus on the English skills, as well as, more contact with your teacher. Accommodation

BELS offers special rates on accommodation such as host families, student residences & shared apartments. Our accommodation provides you with the opportunity to enhance your English learning experience through meeting, living and socializing with locals and people from all over the world.

BELS Residence

Enjoy the full student experience by living in shared accommodation, either in the country-side or at the sea-side. The BELS country-side residence is a large townhouse located in a quiet street in the same village as the school, i.e. Kerċem. The premises fall in the 'comfort' category as per the Malta Tourism Authority regulations. All six private bedrooms are spacious, bright, airy and well-furnished. The rooms are available for double,

twin or single use. For added comfort, all bedrooms are supplied with a fan in summer and a heater in winter. Bed linen & towels are supplied and changed once a week. Sharing facilities include a sitting/ dining area, a well-equipped kitchen, a bathroom and a shower room. A TV and telephone are available in the sitting/ kitchen area. Outdoor facilities include a garden and sun terraces.

Standard Home Stay

Staying with a family is the best way to experience family life on Gozo and to practise your new English skills outside the classroom. Students are treated as though they are members of the household. Our host-families are open-minded, helpful and friendly.



Superior Home Stay

Superior home stay accommodation is the same as standard home stay, except that you will have exclusive use of bedrooms of a higher standard. This type of accommodation is ideal for mature students, business executives, professionals or any other student who is prepared to pay extra to have private comforts. You may book private bathrooms and air-conditioning, at an extra cost.

Country-side Private Self-catering Apartments

This is a block of 4 self-catering apartments that are located in a quiet village street. All units are two bed-roomed and enjoy wonderful country views from good sized terraces. Each unit includes bedrooms, sitting/dining room facilities, a well-equipped kitchen and a shower/bath room. Other facilities include a fan in summer and gas heater in winter. Linen and towels are changed once weekly. Units are available for both sharing and single use and are available all year round.



Sea-side Self-catering Apartments

The sea-side apartments are located a few minutes away from the sea-front. All areas of the apartments are easily accessible to persons with special needs. Students may opt to book studio apartments (maximum 2 persons) or one bedroom apartments (maximum 4 persons). Each apartment consist of a kitchen/living room, bathroom with bathtub/shower, as well as other commodities such as electrical shaving socket and hair-dryer. Other amenities include a flat screen TV with 16 international channels, air-conditioning, direct dial telephones, room safe and internet connection (at an extra cost).

Hotels

Upon request, BELS may also book a choice of hotels.

Transfer Service

The school offers the possibility of booking your arrival and departure transfers from Malta International Airport to your accommodation on Gozo and vice versa. This may be done by bus or private taxi or alternatively, the totally hassle-free straight-through taxi transfer.

Our Island Gozo



The Isle of Calypso, a unique island which forms a part of the Maltese archipelago and lies at the centre of the Mediterranean. Gozo, known as Għawdex (pronounced "audesch") is the Maltese name for Malta's sister island. It is approximately 14.5km long and approximately 7.5km wide, with a shore line of 43km and a population of around 28,000. The island of Gozo is situated 25 minutes away from Malta and is accessible via ferry boat or sea-plane.

When compared to Malta, the beautiful island of Gozo has quite a distinctive character and is more socially conservative. Strict policies regarding building developments keep Gozo unspoilt, greener and more fertile. The Gozitan way of life is mainly based on agriculture and fishing. Life on Gozo is slower and more relaxed than that on Malta. Gozitans are renowned for their splendid sense of hospitality and a fairly

laid back attitude to life that appeals to most visitors. Flat-topped hills and intensely cultivated fields characterize the landscape, whilst the coast has rugged cliffs, steep valleys and beautiful inlets. Baroque churches and old stone farmhouses dot the countryside. With sunny weather, expansive beaches, a thriving nightlife and 7,000 years of history, there is a great deal to see and do. Anything from historical sites, forts and

amazing panoramas, as well as one of the archipelago's best-preserved prehistoric temples. Steeped in myth, Gozo is thought to be the legendary Calypso's Isle from Homer's Odyssey - a peaceful, mystical backwater. Gozo's rugged landscape and spectacular coastline await exploration with some of the Mediterranean's best dive sites. Gozo also boasts memorable nightlife, a diverse cultural calendar and fabulous dining experiences.

Top 3 things to do when on Gozo:

- Hire a bicycle for a faster way to visit the unspoilt countryside of the island.
- Go diving - explore the island's uncontaminated waters.
- Attend the school's Friday night dinners - they are a great way to make new friends and to eat delicious Gozitan food.

Leisure

There is no fixed leisure programme for adult learners; nonetheless BELS organizes weekly cultural and entertainment activities. The warm summers and mild winters that characterise the Mediterranean climate make BELS and Gozo the ideal location for individuals seeking to combine daily educational self-improvement with enjoyable holiday making in the evenings and at the weekends.

In cooler months, the most popular activities comprise visits to historical & archaeological sites, museums and other places of interest. Strolls through the quaint narrow streets of old villages, scenic walking, trekking as well as motor biking and jeep safaris are also very popular.

During the summer boat excursions to caves, swimming in the clear seas or simply sunbathing are all favourite pastimes of our clients.

Nightlife too, can be very entertaining. Gozo offers a vast array of restaurants that serve international cuisine, bars and discotheques, while the more sombre can pursue lyric operas and theatre presentations.

Facilities at international standards are available for indoor and outdoor sports.



Ġgantija Temples

The Ġgantija Temples are located in Xagħra and are one of the most important archaeological sites on the Maltese Islands. Round in shape and containing statues of full-figured goddesses, the Ġgantija temples were dedicated to the Great Earth Mother. The site was a place of pilgrimage for the ancient inhabitants of Malta.



Bays, Beaches and Myths

Xlendi Bay is a popular beach and lies to the southwest side of Gozo. Its small sandy beach is ideal for young and old, an ideal diving site even for beginners.



Ramla Bay is the most sought after beach in summer, when hundreds of locals and tourists visit its sandy shores daily for swimming and sunbathing.



Churches

There are an abundance of churches scattered all over the island, reflecting the religious Gozitan culture.



Diving

Gozo is the underwater jewel of the Mediterranean. It is most noted for the clearest waters, breath taking drop offs, numerous caves, tunnels and the dramatic underwater scenery. Typical fish sightings include: Groupers, Barracudas, Octopus, Bream & Amberjacks.



Festas

The festa season in Gozo is spread over the Summer week-ends. During these weekends, each town or village celebrates the feast of its patron saint. The evening often ends with a fireworks display, which lights up the skies and are amazing to see.



The BELS Malta Centre

Our international language school is situated in the north east of the island of Malta in the heart of the picturesque tourist town of St. Paul's Bay.



The locality of St. Paul's Bay is one of the largest ones on the island. The district is a blend of touristic, residential, agricultural and fishing areas. It is made up of some particularly beautiful natural and geological features. All this is further highlighted by the fact that the region remained practically unspoiled for millennia. It was only during this last century that the area was "developed".

Nonetheless, San Pawl il-Baħar (the Maltese name for the town) is also known for its traditions and archeology. This tourist town has been an important commercial and agricultural centre since prehistoric times and as evident from the name itself, is hallmarked by the legend of the shipwreck of St. Paul

which occurred within the period of 60AD.

The BELS centre is a very modern building, directly located on the central bus route and surrounded by amenities such as the local council, post office, banks and various shops. It is also only a stone's throw away from the sea-side. The school consists of 8 spacious, well-lit air-conditioned classrooms. The common areas were specifically designed to meet your needs, offering easy access to computers for continued study and internet access, a self-access centre that encourages study and relaxation, as well as coffee and snack vending machines. The school is also accessible to persons with special needs.

Accommodation

BELS Malta offers a wide range of accommodation options, from school operated residences to English speaking host families and hotels. All our options are located between a 10 minute walk and a 30 minute bus journey from the school. We consider accommodation to be a key aspect of your stay, it is therefore a priority for us to find the type of accommodation that is most suitable for your needs.



BELS SUPERIOR Residence

The residence consist of 4 neighbouring, 3 bed-roomed apartments, each comfortably furnished, with bedrooms which are fully air-conditioned and which can be booked for private use or shared with other students. Every unit consists of a living area with TV, bathroom (private bathroom may be booked) and a fully equipped kitchen. These living areas offer you breathtaking open sea views and free WiFi.

Our Island Malta

The Maltese Archipelago is situated at the Centre of the Mediterranean, less than 95km south of Italy. With a history that dates back to the 6th century BC, Malta has only recently earned its reputation as being one of the most popular English language learning destinations in Europe. The 150 years of British rule have left a lasting effect on its language making English one of the island's official languages.

Malta & Gozo became a sovereign independent state within the Commonwealth on the 21st September 1964. On 13th December 1974 Malta became a Republic. On the 1st May 2004 the Maltese Islands became part of the European Union.

The native English tongue, warm Mediterranean climate, year round sunshine and clear blue sea are just some of the things that lend themselves so well to choosing Malta as a destination.

Malta has managed to strike the right balance between traditional hospitality and a cosmopolitan spirit born of our millennial history of welcoming people.

Top 3 things to do on Malta:

- Visit a Maltese 'festa' - watch the band playing, visit the beautifully lit church, taste some Maltese nougat and enjoy the award winning fireworks.
- Try a Maltese snack such as 'pastizzi', a flaky pastry with a goat's cheese or pea and onion filling.
- Take home a Maltese souvenir - there are many to choose from - home-made honey or olive-oil, lace, silver filigree jewellery, knitwear, ceramics and locally blown glass ornaments.

Culture and Heritage: Malta served as a strategic base and idyllic retreat to numerous invaders, from the Phoenicians to the British. The islands offer a wide variety of cultural and historical sites, bustling cities and picturesque villages, some of which are recognized as UNESCO world heritage Centres.



Food and Drink: The Maltese bread (ħobza), with its crisp crust and soft inside, is mouth-watering. Typical Maltese dishes include Lampuki Pie (fish pie), Rabbit Stew, Bragioli (beef olives). Malta and Gozo offer a range of low-priced and palatable red and white wines. A popular locally produced soft drink is Kinnie. It is made from oranges and herbs and is a very refreshing drink.



Sun & Sea: The contrast between the glow of the sun and the deep blue of the surrounding sea offers a breath-taking spectacle. Malta offers a number of sandy beaches which are the most obvious choice, but bathing off the rocks is also extremely popular.



Vibrant Nightlife: There are a variety of open air events, parties, clubs, bars and casinos to choose from. The island's small towns and villages have their own band clubs, family run restaurants and intimate wine bars.

Shopping: If you are after a good bargain, then make sure you visit the Sunday open-air markets in Valletta and in Marsaxlokk.

Natural Escapes: Due to the undoubtedly great advantage of fair weather, the Maltese Islands lend themselves to outdoor activities. The Islands offer trekkers some of the most stunning views in the Mediterranean.

The BELS Long Term Programmes

This course targets those learners who are taking the time to seriously focus on their English language skills. With a minimum booking of 8 weeks, you can attend 20 or 30 lessons per week, which will focus on giving you a balanced practice in both systems and skills using general topics.

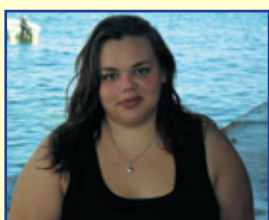
The 20 lesson programme focuses on plenty of practice in the four language skills using general topics.
